NORTHERN DEVELOPMENT BRANCH

The purpose of the Northern Development Branch is to participate in developing and maintaining a socio-economic environment in Northern Alberta which gives maximum opportunity for the inhabitants of the area to grow and prosper.

In acheiving its purpose the Branch provides administrative and technical support to the Northern Alberta Development Council; coordinates the Federal/Provincial Alberta North Subsidiary Agreement; and implements a flexible strategy of achieving socio-economic improvements in Northern Alberta.

The Branch is organized into three sectors: Program Development, Program Co-ordination and Council Administration. Program Development provides the survey and analysis function to support the Northern Alberta Development Council in its public information and monitoring role in Northern Alberta. This section also reacts to policy requests of the Minister and department officials.

Program Co-ordination is responsible for implementation of the Alberta North Agreement and facilitates and assists in the delivery of a wide variety of government programs in Northern Alberta.

Council Administration responds to the many administrative and technical support needs of the Northern Alberta Development Council.

While the Northern Development Branch has the same overall economic development objectives as the rest of the department of Business Development and Tourism, its involvement in the social aspects of the North gives it a unque role. This is emphasized by the Branch's role as Provincial Co-ordinator of the \$55 million Alberta North Subsidiary Agreement which seeks to provide maximum benefits in the areas of human development, community services, social adjustment and economic development.

The Branch seeks to advance the development of human and natural resources in Northern Alberta, as well as aiding in community development goals such as local decision making and planning. It delves into a wide variety of issues as a result of briefs to the Northern Alberta Development Council - health services, manpower training, community infrastructure, education, law enforcement, housing conditions, transportation and communication services, resource development, etc.

In its work as a co-ordinator and facilitator, and supplier of technical support to the Northern Alberta Development Council, the Branch from its new office in Peace River will help maintain a vital communications link between northern people and government.
