## NADC Bursary Program Updates

- The NADC Selection Committee is finalizing the recipients and all students will be notified by end of July, 2020.
- Selection Committee for FNMI will meet this summer and all students will be notified of their application status by the end of August, 2020.

### **Economic Recovery and Northern Strategy**

- The NADC is focused on supporting the north to transition back into full economic activity. The provincial government has announced supports for businesses who were impacted by the pandemic, and as we cautiously enter Phase 3 of re-launch, economic growth to facilitate job creation will be a key focus for the Council.
- Government has released its response to the <u>Fair Deal Panel</u>. The release outlines work and direction underway to support the north through the NADC. "NADC will continue to focus on the development of one or more multi-modal corridors across the north, which would include broadband, utilities, roadways, and rail. Alberta will develop a Northern Strategy for Alberta, which will further develop the corridor concepts and complement the work of other provincial and territorial members of the Northern Minister's Development Forum."

### **Construction of Grande Prairie Hospital Complete**

The NADC is pleased that the construction of the new regional hospital in <u>Grande Prairie</u> is now complete. The facility will deliver a wide range of medical and health services to northern residents and we look forward to the facility becoming fully functional in the coming year.
